STEP 1

Sign the parent consent (under 18) and submit it to Award Leader/ NAO



STEP 3

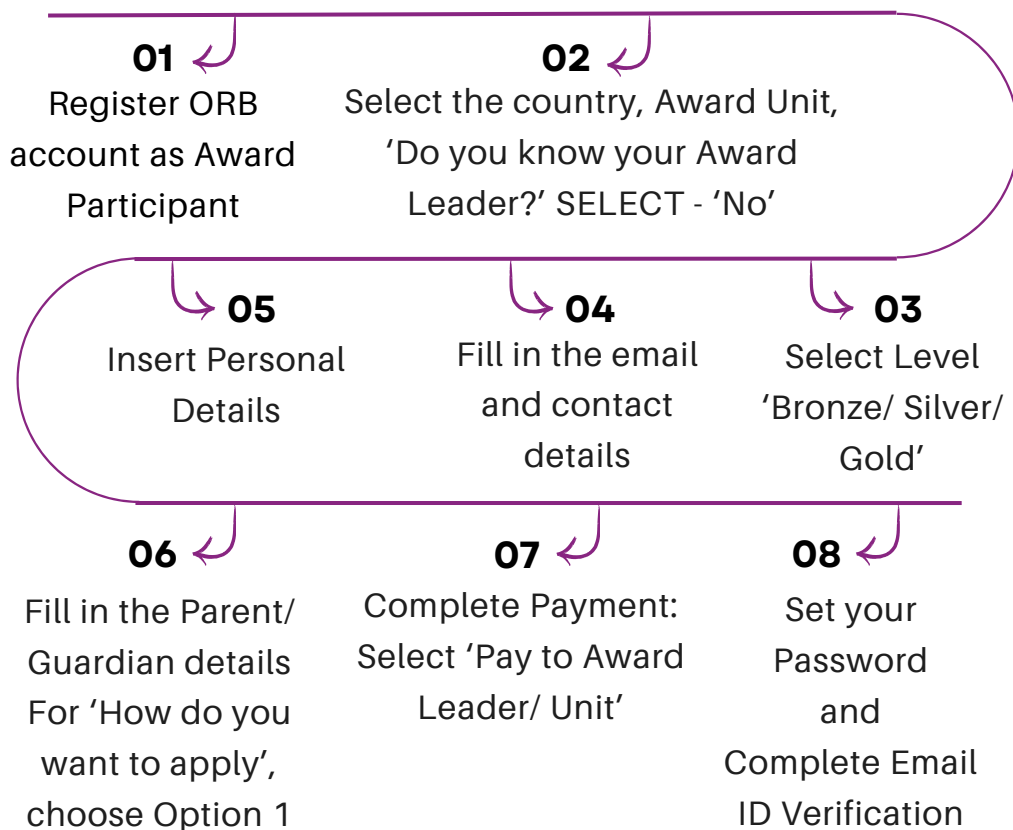
Make the payment based on the award level and email the details
